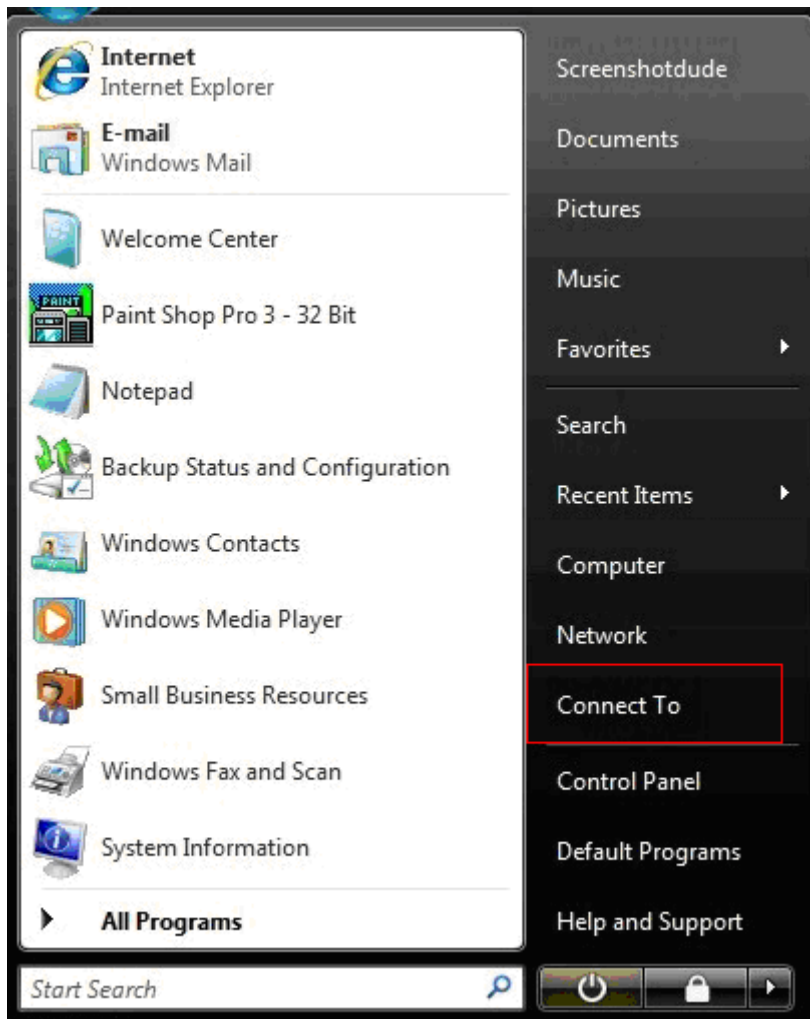


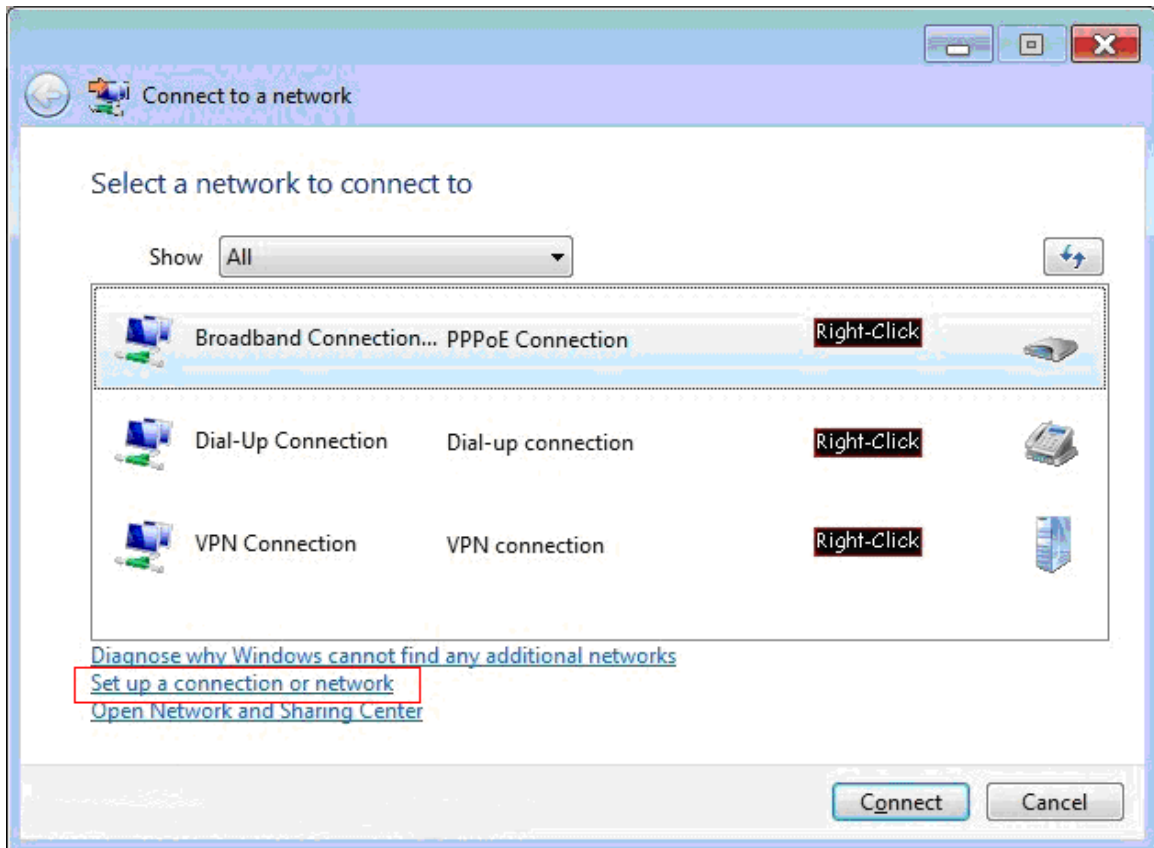


Dialup setup: Windows Vista

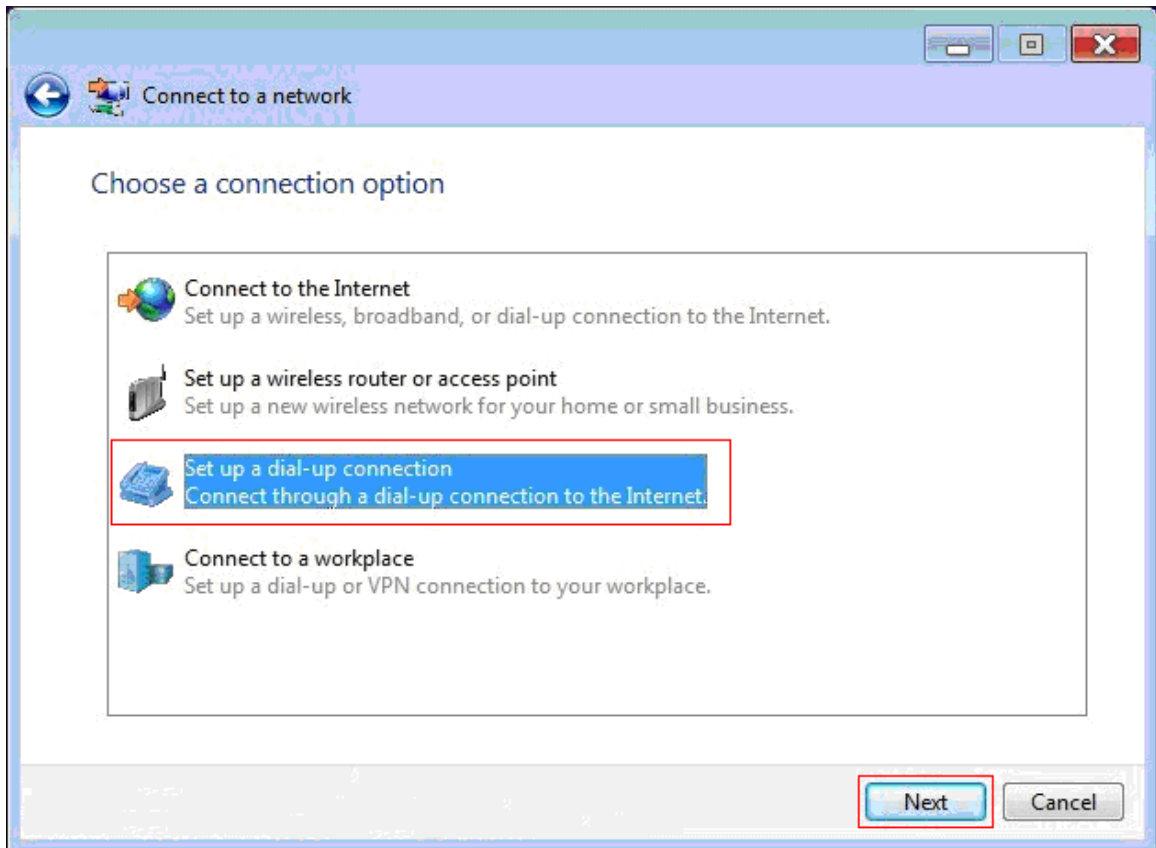
1. Click **Start - Connect To**



2. Click on **Set up a connection or network**



3. Click on **Set up a dial-up connection** once and click **Next**.



4. Enter **0198331292**, your **Netbay account username** and **Password** as shown below. Rename **Dialup Connection** to **Netbay Internet**.

Note: Do not include @netbay.com.au at the end of your username.

Click **Connect** when done.

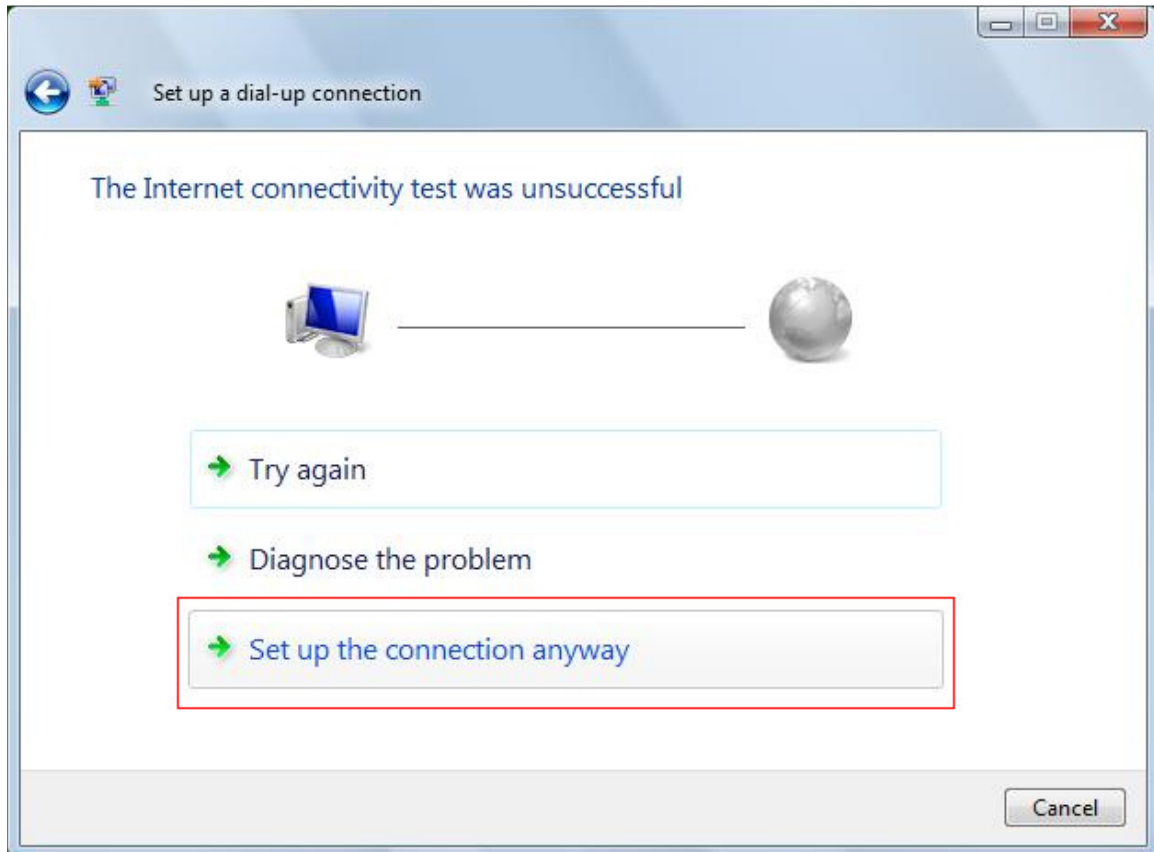
